

ORDINANCE NO. 1098

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROBSTOWN, TEXAS, AMENDING THE 2020-2021 BUDGET FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, the Robstown City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1093 authorizing an operating budget for Fiscal Year Ending 2021; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Fiscal Year Ending 2021 budget, circumstances have arisen during the fiscal year which have, or will require the expenditure of additional funds in some of the line items of the budget, and for which there is more than adequate funding in the line items that will be under-utilized this fiscal year as originally budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the public interest to amend the total Fiscal Year Ending 2021 Operating Budget by adjusting various budget accounts as outlined in **Exhibit A**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROBSTOWN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The findings and recitations set out in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct, and they are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes an amendment as outlined in **Exhibit A**; incorporated herein for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance should be declared invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Robstown.
