The U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) 63d Readiness Division (RD) announces the availability of the following Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) for evaluating the potential environmental effects associated with the Proposed 60-Foot Access Easement (TX160) and construction of a roadway and related infrastructure within the easement for access into the City of Robstown's Public Works Compound utilizing a 0.9790-acre tract of land located on a 50.283-acre federally owned parcel. A 30-day public review and comment period of the Draft EA and Draft FNSI is required by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) (Title 42 of the *United States Code* § 4321 *et seq.*), and the Council on Environmental Quality *Regulations for Implementing the Procedural Provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act* (Title 40 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* [CFR] Parts 1500–1508) and the U.S. Army's regulation for implementing NEPA (32 CFR Part 651). The public review period will begin on **February 19, 2023** and end on **March 21, 2023**.
