WHEREAS, The Fair Housing Act, enacted on April 11, 1968, enshrined into federal law the goal of eliminating racial segregation and ending housing discrimination in the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, sex, age, disability, familial status or national origin, and disability, and commits recipients of federal funding to affirmatively further fair housing in their communities; and

WHEREAS, The City of Robstown is committed to the mission and intent of Congress to provide fair and equal housing opportunities for all. Our social fabric, the economy, health and environment are strengthened in dives, inclusive communities; and

WHEREAS, More than fifty years after the passage of the Fair Housing Act, discrimination persists, and many communities remain segregated; and

WHEREAS, The City of Robstown has appointed the City Secretary and Finance Director as the City's Fair Housing Coordinators to oversee the implementation of Fair Housing Policies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The City of Robstown, do hereby proclaims, April 2025 as

"Fair Housing Month"

in the City of Robstown and do hereby urge all the citizens of this locality to become aware of and support the Fair Housing law.
